The Ansuz Powerswitches are so called because there's a low voltage output beneath every RJ45 Ethernet socket – these are provided to power Ansuz's active Ethernet cables.

In our test, we said: "This switch brings a depth of sound; a roundness and body to voices and instruments that is obvious without comparison."

We added: "You really don't know what streaming audio is capable of until you hear it with a network switch of this calibre."

Mainz8 D3 Power Distributor

The 3 in D3 indicates that this is the third iteration of Ansuz Acoustics' popular Mainz8 power distributors. While not a power conditioner *per se*, the Mainz8 D3 uses eight active zirconium Tesla coils as a part of its third-generation 'analogue dither technology' to keep noise and power-borne resonance at bay.

Testing it, our reviewer found it was remarkably good at keeping noise out of their system, saying: "It's proof that clean power delivered without compromising current delivery is the lifeblood of a high-resolution sound system."

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Ansuz Acoustics is part of Audio Group Denmark, which was founded in late 2020 by Lars Kristensen and Michael Børresen.

The group also owns the Aavik Acoustics, Axxess and Børresen brands.

Originally a cable and resonance control brand, Ansuz then moved into ethernet switches – its aim is

to create premium accessories designed to enhance the performance of hi-fi systems by reducing noise and resonance.
